Genaro Perez went to rest on September 11, 2020 and now awaits the Lord's second coming by his beloved late wife's side. He was 88 years old. He is survived by his three children Maria Esther, Genaro David and his wife Aida, and Elsa Nelly and her husband Pedro. He also leaves behind eight grandchildren and 1 great-grand child, 7 brothers and sisters and countless nieces and nephews. He was a kind and gentle person who loved eating tacos and going to church. He was born in Marin, Nuevo Leon and met his wife of 42 years in Monterrey. He came to live in the United States after they wed in 1962. He worked over 30 years at the Red Carpet Restaurant as a bartender and 10 years at the Mariachi Bar in the Mi Tierra Restaurant where he only left due to illness when he was 77 years old. He was a quiet, but strong man who was always willing to lend a helping hand and would give the shirt off of his back if it was needed. He taught everyone who knew him what it was to have a strong work ethic, how to be an amazing, supportive father, and what it was to be a truly devoted husband. He will be greatly missed, but will never be forgotten. Due to the pandemic, his service will be livestreamed from the Mission Park South Funeral Home on Thursday night at 6:30 pm and his burial will be at the San Jose Mission Cemetery on Friday morning at 9:30 am.
