Geoffrey M. Hoeft Jeff was born June 5, 1947 in Sheboygan WI. He was called home by our Lord Jesus Christ on September 10, 2013 after losing his battle with head/neck cancer. Jeff graduated from Stanford University Engineering April 2, 1970 and was drafted into the Army May 15, 1970. He served with the Americal Division in Viet Nam from May 1970 until March 1972. He received the National Defense Service Medal, Viet Nam Service Medal w/2 Bronze Service Stars; SS Badge w/M16 Rifle Bar. He attended graduate school in Denver after being honorably discharged from the Army. After completing his duty with the Army reserves, he moved to San Antonio in October 1972, where he was hired as an Aeronautical Engineer at Kelly AFB. He traveled to various countries during his 35 year civil service career. He earned his MBA Finance from UTSA in December 1976. Jeff was preceded in death by his parents, Merle and Mary Jane Hoeft. He is survived by his wife of 31 years, Mary, his three children Brian Hoeft, Jennifer H. Giovannelli Stephen, and Kris Kailimai Tere. He has 6 grandchildren. He was a man of integrity, reserved and quiet, a wonderful husband, father and grandfather.
