George A Craig was born 11/2/46 in St Louis, MO. He died 10/12/13 in his home in San Antonio, TX surrounded by family and friends. George was married for 33 years to Cheryl Russell-Craig in San Antonio, where they founded Alamo Lot Maintenance, a parking lot & street sweeping company. Along with running ALM for 30 years, George enjoyed artist blacksmithing, fabricating parts for his fleet of trucks, traveling, problem solving and teaching. He is most remembered for his intellect and humor and always had a book close by. George was truly a scholar and a gentleman, with a passion for inspiring people to reach their dreams. He served in the Army as an 18 Delta Special Forces Medical Specialist and was honorably discharged in 1974. He hosted The Tuesday Night Hammer Ins at his blacksmithing forge on W. Rhapsody. For over 10 years novice blacksmiths and members of the Balcones Forge gathered to learn and share their love of shaping metal. He has requested that The Tuesday Hammer Ins continue in his absence.
