



George Myers Dannenfelsler

May 15, 1932 - August 2, 2021

George Myers Dannenfelsler, 89 years old, peacefully passed from his home in San Antonio, Texas to be at home with the Lord on August 2, 2021. For the last ten years of his life, he had daily expressed appreciation to Jean (Marihart) Dannenfelsler, his wife of 39 years, for being his faithful caregiver.

George was born to Marie and Clarence Dannenfelsler in Haven, Kansas, May 15, 1932 and is survived by his sister, Elma Oppenheimer, age 91 of Tucson, Arizona. He attended Kansas State College for a year before he entered the US Army in 1952, where he attended Missile School and became an instructor and technician at Huntsville, Alabama. He returned to Kansas State College where he finished his Bachelors degree in Electrical Engineering. He was employed by Honeywell Aeronautical, various other engineering firms in Salt Lake City, Tucson and Phoenix Arizona, and served as builder and operator for two manufacturing plants in Denver, Colorado and San Antonio, Texas. He was working as a quality control engineer for Bausch and Lomb for the production of lenses when he retired in 1998.

George and Jean met at church in Denver, Colorado during a greeting time. As they turned to greet each other Jean said to George, "Haven't we met before?" After that, George said he made a special effort to sit with Jean at church and they married September 25, 1981. It was a second marriage for both and they made a blended family of their grown children: Steven (wife

Tika) Dannenfelser, Paul (wife Rose) Dannenfelser, Bruce (wife Pam) Marihart, Donna Marihart, Collette Marihart, and Michelle Post (deceased). George leaves a legacy of many grandchildren and great grandchildren.

George and Jean were members of Cornerstone Church in San Antonio for over 30 years. They served as counselors in the Billy Graham Crusade in San Antonio in 1997. His hobby was building model sailing ships. "The way I understand George's life," stepdaughter Collette said, "is that he met Jesus at the Cross, and faithfully followed him all the way home."
