George E. Hurlock, Jr., Major USAF Ret, died on February 9, 2011 at the age of 90. He was born on February 9, 1921 in Indiantown, VA. He is preceded in death by his mother, Katherine V. Hurlock; father, George E. Hurlock, Sr.; his sister, Hazel Bergstrom, and brother, Warren L. Hurlock. He is survived by his beloved wife of 69 wonderful years, Mary Lou; sons, David and his wife, Rose of Lakehills, TX and Donald of San Antonio, TX; brothers, Calvin of Denison, TX, Ted and wife, Joan of Groton, CT, Bernie and wife, Mary Francis of Upper Marlboro, MD and sister Anne of Silver Springs, MD. He has three grandsons, Michael, Matthew and Mark, and five great-grandchildren. George graduated from Unionville High School, Unionville, VA and attended Strayer Business College, Washington, DC. A veteran of World War II and the Korean War, he served in the North East Command, China-Burma-India Theater of Operations, and with the USAF Security Service in Turkey. After completing 26 years of military service he retired from the Air Force in 1965 having served in the Air Training Command, North East Command, USAF Security Service Air Intelligence Command. George received the Air Force Commendation Medal, the Air Defense Service Medal, American Campaign Medal, Asiatic-Pacific Campaign Medal, the National Defense Service Medal and WWII Victory Medal as well as the Meritorious Civilian Service Award. Following retirement he returned to USAF Security Service as a civil servant retiring in 1983 after completing 20 years of Federal Civil Service. His entire

career was in Military Personnel. He was an ordained Elder in the Good Shepherd Presbyterian Church and served as Treasurer and Clerk of Session for a number of years. He spent his retirement years as a volunteer with the Lackland AFB Retiree Activities Office, his church and the Valley-Hi Masonic Lodge #1407 AF & AM and an endowed 32nd Degree Scottish Rite Mason. A Memorial Service in Celebration of George's life will be held at Good Shepherd Presbyterian Church, 725 Cedarhurst Dr., San Antonio TX at 10:00 AM on Thursday, February 17, 2011. The Rev.
