Born on September 16, 1933 in Anthony, Kansas, he spent his childhood in Wakita, Oklahoma. He graduated from Wakita High School in 1951. He attended Oklahoma State University and graduated in 1959 with a degree in Geology. He moved to San Antonio and worked as a well logger for an oilfield service company. He founded Knight Well-Log Service in 1961 with partner, R.L. Huffman. He organized Double G Energy & Exploration, Inc. in 1985 and formed Long Oil & Natural Gas in 2000.

He is a long-standing member of American Association of Petroleum Geologists and the South Texas Geological Society, a member of Oklahoma City Geological Association, a charter member of the San Antonio Petroleum Club and a member of Oak Hills Country Club. He enjoyed golf, traveling, watching sports, computer programming and going to the movies. He was often featured on the big screen at Spurs games performing his awkward Dad dance. He and his wife, Sharon went on numerous ocean and river cruises in Eastern and Western Europe, Scandinavia, South American, Alaska, Hawaii and Australia.

Preceded in death by his parents, Leonard and Mary Lee Long, his sister

Mary Jane Miller and a son, Michael Long.

Survived by his wife of 33 years, Sharon Long, a daughter Michelle Long Hagli and husband, Chad of Austin and grandchildren, Savannah, Sierra and Shane Held. Also, surviving are stepsons, Brad Nelson of Frisco, Greg Nelson and wife Kelly of Boerne and stepdaughter, Paige Mazurek and husband John of Santa Fe, NM.
