George Martin Moldenauer, MSG, USAF Ret., long-time resident of San Antonio, passed away peacefully in Round Rock, TX, on August 4, 2012 at the age of 87. He served in WW II with the 8th Air Force, 1st Air Division-40th Combat Bombardment Wing H 305th Bombardment Group in England; he also served during the Korean and Vietnam Wars.
