He was an artistic baker of cakes and pastries, as well as a wonderful cook especially of exotic game. He was employed by Trinity University for over 30 years. Jerry was an avid hunter and fisherman and was involved with the Audubon Society. He had a great talent for mimicking wild bird calls and truly enjoyed this pastime. His lifelong passion for the outdoors also included serving as a mentor for children in guided deer hunts and he was a State Hunter Education Instructor. In his 19 years of teaching he certified 916 hunters in 73 different classes. He also worked at the Bass Pro Shops as a sales associate and a Conceal Carry facilitator. Jerry was a commissioned Deputy Game Warden for over 13 years under the tutelage of his longtime friend Texas Parks & Wildlife Cpt. Danny

Villalobos. Jerry loved spending time with his children and grandchildren showing them the wonders of the great outdoors and his love for breeding and caring for his Labrador Retrievers. He will be greatly missed by his family and friends especially his daughter's godfather and lifetime friend Joseph S. Michalec.
