Beloved husband, father, and grandfather, Gilbert Delgado, born December 26, 1935, went to be with the Lord on March 14, 2022 at the blessed age of 86. He was born in San Antonio, Texas to Alfredo and Guadalupe Delgado. Gilbert graduated from Jefferson High School in 1953 and joined the United States Marine Corps that same year.
