He distinguished himself on the football field, earning several accolades, including a football scholarship to Trinidad State College in Colorado. He embarked on a remarkable career that spanned over 50 years, dedicated to the Bexar County Courthouse and the United States Federal Courthouse, where he served as the Judicial Assistant

for the Western District of Texas under Honorable Fred Biery. Gibby was the embodiment of a committed court staff member, and public servant.
