Gilberto M. Segura, passed away on January 6, 2024, in San Antonio, Texas. He was born on January 16, 1933, in San Benito, Texas to Martin Segura and Manuela Martinez. Gilbert is preceded in death by his beloved wife, Maria R. Segura, by his parents, his brothers, Felix, Antonio and Martin Segura, and by his sister, Concepcion Segura. He is survived by his children, Annie Cardenas (Jim), Gilbert Segura, Jr. (Adela), Arnie Segura (Kathleen), Dalia Flores (Jim) and Martin Segura (Cindy), 8 grandchildren and 6 great-grandchildren.

Gilbert was a loving and devoted husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, son, brother, and friend. He left an unforgettable mark on the hearts of all who knew him. He dedicated his life to the happiness of his wife, Mary, and their family. Gilbert always took the family on vacations to South Padre Island or Garner State Park, traveled to the valley to see family, and created annual traditions of going to the rodeo, the circus, and the ice capades.

A true patriarch, Gilbert coached each of his three sons in baseball and basketball, instilling values of teamwork and discipline. His commitment extended beyond the family, as his love for football and basketball found him officiating these games, first for junior high then for high school. His wife Mary would often enjoy watching him from the stands. This cherished part time hobby spanned an impressive 40 years when he retired at the age of 78. His

commitment to the sports community reflected his passion for football and basketball, leaving an enduring impact on the games he loved.

Gilbert's career began early in the world of aviation, having begun as an aircraft mechanic working for Pan American in California and earning a coveted license, showing unwavering work ethic and passion. He moved his family back to San Antonio in the early 1960's landing a job at Kelly Air Force Base where he ascended through the ranks and eventually reached middle management. He not only contributed to the aviation field but also demonstrated leadership by heading an industrial engineering team until his well-deserved retirement.

Gilbert loved family gatherings and being with his beloved wife, Mary, whether going out to dinner or watching Natalia Jimenez or Juan Gabriel concerts on TV. He enjoyed dancing with Mary and socializing at the NCO club with friends. Gilbert and Mary were also active in their community for many years, volunteering as Presiding Judges for the Election Poll at Mary F. Huppertz Elementary School and volunteering at the annual Folklife Festival coordinating ticket takers for the gate entrances. He was a faithful man committed to his faith in God and the Catholic Church and its teachings. His zest for life and dedication to his loved ones will forever be remembered. He leaves behind a legacy of love, commitment, and a life well-lived.

Visitation will be held Monday, January 15, 2024 from 6:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. with a Rosary at 7:00 p.m. at Mission Park Funeral Chapels North.
