



## Glen Edwin Prichard

September 8, 1923 - October 17, 2015

Glen Edwin Prichard, of San Antonio, Texas, died on October 17, 2015.

Mr. Prichard was born on September 8, 1923, on the Brown Ranch at Fall River, Kansas, to Ross and Grace Shelton Prichard. He joined the army at a young age and while stationed at Ft. Sam in San Antonio, Texas, he met his future wife, Grace Millsap. She preceded his death in 2003. His son John Red Eldridge also preceded him in death in November 2014.

Mr. Prichard served during World War 2 and was on the 2nd wave on Omaha Beach. He retired from the army on December 31, 1996 as Sergeant first class.

O'pa would often quote poetry, sing songs and tell his grandkids stories of being bombed while in London and the things he had seen while in France and other places where he was stationed during war. He could recall exactly what he was doing on just about any day of the year. He could remember the name and rank of everyone he served under while in the army and all the men's name and rank that served under him. He could quote all the presidents and their terms. He was what you would call "old school." He never had a credit card or cell phone. He lived his life as he wanted for many years always had one beer a day.

Survivors include daughter, Linda Barrett, of San Antonio, her husband Gene, 5 grandchildren and 6 great grandchildren.

He will be buried at Ft, Sam Houston National Cemetery.
