Gloria was a strong independent woman and raised her children as a single mother. 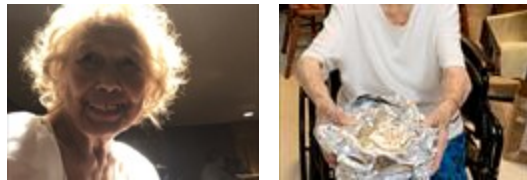

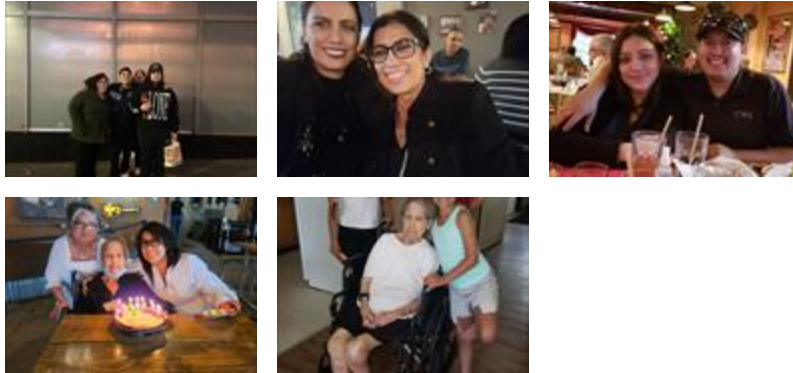

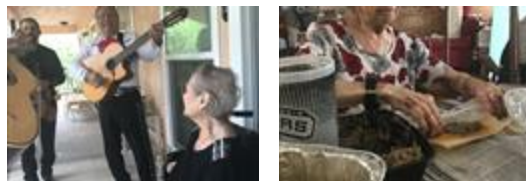
