



## Gloria Garland Pianta Homburg

September 24, 1926 - August 29, 2014

Gloria Garland Pianta Homburg died on Friday, August 29 at the age of 87. She was a resident of San Antonio for 70 years before moving to Ft Worth in 2000.

Gloria was born on September 24, 1926 in Bristol, Virginia to Florence and James E. Garland. Gloria came to San Antonio with her parents in 1928. She graduated from Brackenridge High School in 1944; San Antonio Jr. College in 1946; and Incarnate Word College in 1948 with a BS in Home Economics. She taught in the NEISD for nine years and in Marble Falls for one year. She was a lifelong member of the Episcopal Church and a charter member of St Francis Episcopal Church in San Antonio where she was the first Director of Christian Education. She also sang in the choir for many years and was often an officer in the Episcopal Church Women's group. Gloria enjoyed many years as a member of the Quelques Fleurs Garden Club.

Upon moving to Ft Worth, she joined All Saints Episcopal Church and was an active member of the St Anne's Guild. She served as Chairman/Manager of the St. Anne's Bookstore for three years.

Gloria was predeceased by her parents and her husbands: John Dale Pianta Jr. and Paul H Homburg, Jr.
