I remember Willie Arguijo was coming to visit his mom and she was at our home with all the other neighbors. They were filing the washer off my finger yikes it got hot. Mr Arguijo came in and said I have a cutter and in less than two minutes my finger was free. Another vivid memory is that Gloria spoke English and Spanish in first grade and she would translate for our classmates. I always admired her. I have two brothers Simon Ramirez (Paul Arguijo's age) a younger brother Arturo Ramirez.
