



## Guillermo "Willie" Lozano

September 27, 1934 - October 2, 2018

Guillermo "Willie" Lozano died on October 2, 2018 of natural causes. He was born in San Antonio, TX on September 27, 1934, to Placido Lozano and Elodia (Aldape) Lozano. He was the fourth of five children: Elodia ("Yoya"); Placido, Jr. ("Pinky"); Alicia; Willie; and Arturo.

At age 15, Willie's father died unexpectedly and he quickly became the man of the house. He took care of his mother and younger brother, Arturo, while completing his education at Fox Tech. In 1955, Willie volunteered to serve in the United States Army. After completing his active duty service in 1958, Willie returned to San Antonio to work at Midcap Bearing.

He met the love of his life, Teresa Mendoza. They married on September 17, 1961. Between 1963 and 1968, their children (Rebecca, Martha, Carlos, Eva, and Daniel) were born. In 1972, Willie started San Antonio Bearing and Supply Company which thrived with significant business from companies in Mexico. His children completed their education, and the girls married.

After quadruple bypass surgery in 2002, Willie closed his business. The character of the man throughout his life is remembered fondly. He loved his children. He quickly acknowledged their uniqueness, special gifts, and talents. He loved his grandchildren and often found himself being the "soccer mom" transporting and watching games.

He is survived by his wife of 57 years, his five children, five grandchildren (Marcelo, Stefan, Emily, Erin and, Sarah), and one great grandchild (Ava).
