



Guillermo Ponce Jr.

June 6, 1935 - August 20, 2023

Mr. Guillermo Ponce, Jr. was born in Laredo, TX on June 6, 1935, and quietly passed away surrounded by his children and grandchildren on August 20, 2023.

Preceded in death by his parents, Guillermo Ponce, Sr. and Emma Guajardo Ponce and his parents-in-law, Manuel Quintanilla, Sr., and Altagracia Castaneda Quintanilla.

Mr. Ponce served with the St. Joseph South San Knights of Columbus Council 7865 and as a CYO baseball coach for a number of years, afterwards joined the Knight of Columbus Council 9017 at San Juan de Los Lagos where he served for a brief period of time.

He worked at Kelly Air Force Base for 36 years as a Computer Systems Analyst, and while there he received numerous awards and recognitions for his outstanding dedication and work ethic.

Mr. Ponce served his country as a United States Marine from 1957 until 1963 and transferred to the United States Naval Reserves in 1972 then joined the United States Air Force Reserves in 1982 and retired in 1995 as a Staff Sergeant.

As an outstanding family man, he always strived to provide a comfortable living for his family and a superior education for his children.

Mr. Ponce is survived by his wife of 55 years, Maria Rosario Quintanilla Ponce, his children, Guillermo Ponce III (Vickie), Gerardo Ponce (Christie), Maria de Lourdes Ponce (James) and Dr. Gilberto M. Ponce (Carmen) and 9 grandchildren, Julian, Araceli, Natalia, Kimberlee, Margarita, Victoria, Gilberto Jr., Karina, and James Jr. Also survived by his sister Ana Maria P. Saenz, and numerous nieces and nephews.

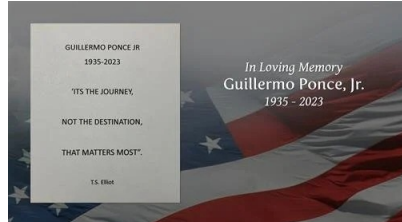
