



Guy Henry Davis

January 9, 1942 - March 7, 2025

Local musician Guy Henry Davis played the drums up to his very last day. His career began in his teens, when he was noticed by Larry Nolan. He was in band at Edison HS: graduated class of 1960. He served in US Navy (1961-1965) and toured with Navy Show Band in Japan. He played Hemisphere World's Fair Band (1968); and during the 1970's-2000's he worked with Jim Cullum, Al Sturchio, Nobuko, Larry Herman, and the SA Rodeo band led by Don Sarli. He played with Junior Pruneda, Dow Daggett, and

Friends in Hunt, Texas his last 20 years.

Guy served his duty here on earth by playing and teaching drumming. His hobbies were cars, motorcycles, and photography. He lived during a golden era in American history and in the SA music scene. He is preceded in death by his third wife Bert Difani; and is survived by his first wife June Davis; two children Guy Todd Davis and Melanie Erin Davis; and nephew Frank Davis. A Veterans memorial will be held at Fort Sam Houston National Cemetery April 30th at 10:30AM
