Born November 2, 1940, at the Robert B. Greene Hospital in San Antonio, Texas, Harold Francis Kruse left his earthly home on his journey to his Heavenly one. He was the son of Eddie Martin Kruse Jr. and Clara Emma Braune. His parents preceded him in death. Harold attended Jefferson High School and joined the Navy in 1959. He was a Vietnam Veteran and served on the USS Lexington and the USS Hancock. Upon his Honorable discharge, he returned to San Antonio and worked for Braniff Airlines for 17 years. He then was self-employed in the transport business for 27 years. His strong work ethic kept driving him to work until his health forced him to retire in January. Beginning his music career as "Hank Stone" in the early 1970s, Harold's greatest passion was singing and playing country music until cancer therapy claimed his voice in 2009. His venue in South Texas and Nashville included performing with Johnny Bush, Darryl McCall, John Anderson, Ray Price and many others too numerous to mention. According to God's unconditional grace, Hank, has now added his beautiful baritone to the Heavenly choir. Throughout his lifelong love of rebuilding and racing high performance cars he formed enduring friendships. Until their joyful reunion in Heaven, he is survived by his soul-mate, his wife, Marilyn Kay Wilson Kruse, one daughter, Mary Katherine Edwards Buddy of Burleson, Texas, two sons, Eddie James Kruse, San Antonio and Richard Kruse, Burleson, Texas and

grandchildren, Mary Ann Kruse, who resided with him, Dalton and Miranda Edwards, Christopher and Micheal and Ryan Kruse and Corey and Alexander Harris.
