November 4, 1923 - June 5, 2017

Harold Wayne Moncus was born on November 4, 1923 in Harlingen, Texas to Charles Wesley and Maggie (Simmons) Moncus. He peacefully entered into rest on June 5, 2017 at the age of 93.

Mr. Moncus served as a Corporal with the 4505th Army-Air Force Base Unit (Air Corps) at Kelly Field, Texas and was honorably discharged in December 1945. It was here where he met and married Florence "Sugar" Moncus.

Harold and Sugar were married 44 years and had 3 children: Kathi (Nix), Wesley and Roger, and together welcomed three of their 8 grandchildren: Debra Nix (Hendry), Jeffrey Nix and Craig Daniel Moncus, prior to her death in October 1989.

He was formerly employed by Linde Industrial Gases and retired in 1984 after over 40 years of service.

In July 1991, Harold married Rosalie Cassata and became a step-father to John, Mike, Cathy (Poye), Marijane (Detranaltes) and Vincent, as well as a step-grandfather and step-great grandfather.

Harold loved to fish with his best friend, Fred Neumann, and go deer hunting with his sons Wesley and Roger and son-in-law David. He was always busy and loved working in his yard, growing tomatoes strawberries, and pretty much anything else he could stick in the ground or a pot. He was also known to shoot errant squirrels who had the nerve to help themselves to the fruit of his pecan trees.

Mr. Moncus is preceded in death by his parents, his brother Jack Moncus, his

wife Florence, his mother and father-in-law Roy and Stella Costello, his daughter Mary Katherine "Kathi" and her husband David Nix.

Harold is survived by his wife of 26 years Rosalie, her children John, Mike, Cathy (Poye), Marijane (Detranaltes) and Vincent, and their children and grandchildren.
