Harriet Marie Moore Plummer, age 92 of San Antonio, Texas, passed away on Sunday evening, January 22, 2023 at 9:45 pm. Harriet was born on May 6, 1930, in Bexar County to Harry and Emma A Riedel Moore. She spent the majority of her life San Antonio and China Grove, a sleepy little town east of San Antonio.

Harriet was preceded in death by her loving parents Harry and Emma Moore, daughters Patricia Plummer, Laureen Branagan, son-in-law John Branagan, sister Ann Cotugno, and niece Kathy Cotugno Edmonds. She is also preceded in death by the man she was crazy about, ELVIS! Harriet had a strong work ethic. She began working at the age of 12 at a startup mailing services company to help her family. She was known to work more than one-job when money was tight to care for her 3 daughters. Harriet finally retired in 2006 at 76, as a Civil Service employee at Randolph Air Force Base where for 32 years she developed, documented, and maintained the flight training manuals.

After retirement, she did lots of traveling with her oldest daughter Laureen/John. She became a little bit of a daredevil by taking a Helicopter ride over the Grand Canyon.

Harriet was a strong, stubborn (comes from the Red hair) and loving woman! She was always there to care for her family. From the backyard parties when her girls were teenagers, to hosting Easter Egg hunts for relatives, taking care of grandkids and enjoying her great grandchildren. Harriet loved it all and we loved her. She will be missed.

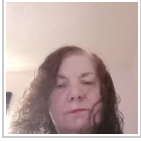
