Harvey Leonard Harvey was born near Sommerset, Texas on November 28, 1916 and is survived by wife, Willie Mae; son, Fred Arnold; 4 grandchildren and 5 great grandchildren. He was the last surviving sibling of father and mother, Ray and Lucy. He had two brothers: Joel and Gilbert and five sisters: Ethel, Alice, Nola Fae, Georgia, and Gladis. He served his country during WW II as a fighter Pilot flying 150 Missions and distinguishing himself as an ace and was a member of the flight that shot down the infamous Japanese General, Yamamoto. He made his living in the oil field and circled the globe twice, but his service was unto the lord. He was a Deacon in the church by the time he was 19 and served as Sunday school teacher, Missionary, Prison Ministry, and Pastor of a church in Simons City. To say he was a character was an understatement. Those that met him will remember him and will often speak of him. He will be missed, but never forgotten.
