Helen Faye Evans Cain, age 90, passed peacefully in her sleep on February 23, 2020. She was born August 2, 1929, near Grady, Oklahoma, to Orbie Cecil and Ruby Lee Evans. Helen and her two sisters, Irma Beth and Orbie, grew up on a working ranch. Her grandparents, Richard and Viola Black of Nocona, Texas, were also involved in her upbringing.

Helen married Bernest H. Cain, Sr., and they began their family. While living in Oklahoma City they accepted a call to the ministry. They enrolled in Bible Baptist College in Springfield, Missouri, where Helen received her degree in Christian Education. Together, they served churches in Missouri, Arkansas and Texas. The last pastorate was at Bible Baptist Church in San Antonio, Texas.

Helen's long life was one of service to others. As a minister's wife, she hosted many pastors, missionaries, church members and those in need. Her dedication to Christian education was demonstrated by her teaching of Sunday School, Kindergarten, Vacation Bible School and numerous youth activities. She was a devout woman of faith and the pages of her Bible were worn from daily reading.

Helen took joy in raising her four children. Her love of reading, education, singing and playing the piano, encouraged her children to become avid

learners. Her family, and community alike, admired her loving, compassionate, caring and supportive nature. Helen was a kind-hearted woman who nurtured others. Her infectious laugh was enough to make anyone feel welcome. You could always find people in her home and around the dinner table. She was an incredible cook, rarely needing a recipe or measuring cups. No one ever left her table hungry. She took pleasure in growing plants and flowers, tending to her garden and preserving food for her family.
