Helen Marguerite Hutchinson Milne, age 92, of San Antonio, Texas, passed away peacefully on August 4, 2016. She was born on April 2, 1924 to Lawrence C. and Ozelia Matherne Hutchinson in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. Helen was a graduate of Baton Rouge Business College and was secretary to the President of the Louisiana Creamery Company. In 1948, she married Albert F. Milne. Their son Albert Jr. was born in 1953.

While Albert was stationed at Hahn Air Base in Germany, the family traveled extensively. Helen taught CCD classes, was active in the Catholic Church and was a member of square dancing clubs and a woman's bowling league. While stationed at Dover Air Force Base in Delaware, the family continued to travel. After Albert retired, the couple traveled widely in the United States, visiting State Parks and spending Helen's 60th birthday on Maui. A devout Catholic and member of St. Luke's Catholic Church, Helen's faith was the guiding force in her life.

She is survived by her brother Joseph and his wife Louise Hutchinson, sister-in-law Muriel Hutchinson and numerous nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death in 2015 by her husband of over 66 years, her beloved son, who died in 1977, her parents, two brothers and two sisters.
