Helen Louise Rone Power, 88, of San Antonio, departed this earth on June 13, 2021. Helen was born to John V. and Velma Louise Sullivan Rone on October 20, 1932 in Union City, Tennessee. A railroad job took the family to Dyersburg, where she grew up. She received her teaching degree from Bethel Christian University in Memphis, where she met and married her husband. Shortly thereafter, they moved to San Antonio, where they raised their three sons, Carl, Tim and John. Helen was a member of Castle Hills Baptist Church for 30 years, where she was active in the choir. She was on the Board of the Salvation Army and could frequently be seen feeding the homeless in downtown San Antonio. Helen loved Jesus and was a devoted student of the Bible. Many people were inspired by her walk of faith. She truly defined what a Christian and a mom was. She is preceded in death by her parents, her brothers: John Holland, Neil Ray and Kenneth Lee Rone, and her sister, Sharon Ann Alvis. “ My friendship with Helen goes back seventy years when we met as freshmen at Bethel College (University) in McKenzie, TN. We were roommates part of that time.

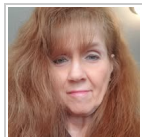
We have kept in touch all these years by way of mail and phone visits. I will miss our many conversations.

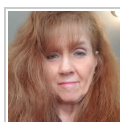
