



## Helen Davis Woldhagen

September 5, 1922 - September 26, 2015

Beloved wife, mother, grandmother, and aunt, Helen Davis Woldhagen was welcomed to her heavenly home with her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on September 26, 2015 at the age of 93. She was preceded in death by her parents, Warren Randolph Davis and Irene Porter Davis, loving husband, Palmer Martin Woldhagen and precious daughter, Beverly Irene James, and an infant son. She is survived by her devoted daughter, Sharon, sister Doris Wilson, and brother Roy Gene Davis Leta, granddaughters Scarlett Collums Richardson Joseph, Heidi Collums Garcia Emiliano, grandsons Cameron James Dawn, Hagen James, great-grandchildren Zayana, E.J., Jim Palmer Garcia and Brayden Mack James.

Helen was born in Fitzgerald, Georgia on September 5, 1922 and the family moved to Tampa, Florida when she was a teenager. She graduated from Hillsboro High School where she met the love of her life and future husband. They were married on May 10, 1942 and the Navy sent them to New York where they remained until the war was over. They went home to Tampa where their daughter, Sharon, was born but moved to San Antonio 11 months later where Palmer joined his father in business at the Woldhagen Lumber company. Shortly thereafter, Palmer and Helen opened Woldhagen Concrete Products and several years later Palmer began Wolco Corporation Prestressed Concrete Construction.

Helen and Palmer were devoted to their church, first known as Woodlawn United Methodist Church, and served on numerous committees and boards. They were among the pioneers when the church grew and moved to De Zavala Road as University United Methodist Church. Together, she and Palmer donated the sanctuary Pipe Organ, Trumpet En Chamade, and Chimes. The organ gained prestige as one of the finest Tracker Organs in the country built by Manual Rosales which was dedicated in 1991.
