Henry William Juenke, 69, of San Antonio, died May 4, 2011 after a long and courageous battle against cancer. He was born to the late Harry William and Frieda Juenke, October 1, 1941 in Kerrville, Texas. Henry graduated from Tivy High School in 1959 and received a BBA from Southwest Texas State College in 1963, and graduated from the Southwest Graduate School of Banking at Southern Methodist University.
