



Henry Berton Moody

February 17, 1913 - August 10, 2005

Henry Berton Bert Moody passed away August 10, 2005 at the age of 92. He was born February 17, 1913 in Hornersville, MO to Georgia Ann Spence and Henry Jefferson Moody. When Bert was a young child, his family moved to Arkansas where he grew up. At age 18, he enlisted in the Army. He was discharged in San Antonio. Afterwards, he played the trombone in the San Antonio Symphony for a number of years and worked with several dance bands. He later worked at Kelly Field, did a stint with the Border Patrol in El Paso and Laredo, and then worked in the oil fields around Kingsville. He went back to Kelly AFB in 1951, where he stayed until he retired. Bert was preceded in death by one son, William Berton Moody, and 10 siblings. He is survived by his wife Ruth, 4 sons: Milton Dwight Moody and wife Catherine of Conroe, TX; Joel Patrick, Michael Dan, and Andrew Roy Moody of San Antonio; and by 3 daughters: Ann Louise Knox and husband Jim of Camp Wood, TX; Mary Eleanor Massey of Round Rock, TX; and Jill Carol Carr and husband Mike of Spring Branch, TX; 11 grandchildren and numerous great-grandchildren.
