Henry Karnes Porter born on July 28, 1917 in Belton, Texas passed away on November 3, 2005 at the age of 88. He served in the Army Air Corp during WWII as a bomber pilot for the 392nd Bomb Group 8th Air Force. He flew 30 combat missions and received the Distinguished Flying Cross. Mr. Porter was a member of Alamo Heights Christian Church. He was preceded in death by his wife, Gladys McBeath Porter in April of 2004; and his brothers, D.B. Porter & Lynn Porter.
