



## Herbert H. Hathaway

September 27, 1931 - May 6, 2007

Herbert H. Hathaway, age 75 passed away on Sunday May 6, 2007 in San Antonio. He was born on September 27, 1931 in Black, Alabama. Herb served for nine years in the United States Air Force and achieved the rank of Staff Sergeant. He left the service in 1956 and began working for the rest of his life in the printing industry. He was the co-founder of Todco Graphic Supply and President of the International Club of Printing House Craftsmen during 1975-1976. Herb was also a Founding Father and Charter Member of the San Antonio Litho Club. He served as Chairman of the Southwestern Graphics Show in 1980 and spent the next 22 years servicing and repairing printing equipment all over South Texas. Herb was a life long member of the Masons and achieved its highest honor as Worshipful Master of the Floresville Masonic lodge in Floresville, Texas. He is survived by his wife of 30 years, Patricia Hathaway; children Jack, Charles, Cheryl, Herbert Jr.; Stepsons Clifford Park, Max Park; 12 Grandchildren and 3 Great Grandchildren.
