Herbert Lee Schwartzman age 75 of San Antonio, passed away unexpectedly on Tuesday, July 21, 2020. He was born in Laredo, Texas and his family moved to San Antonio when he was 5. He graduated from Jefferson High School in 1963. He was a Vietnam Veteran serving in the U.S. Navy on the USS Maury. After he was discharged, he earned a Bachelor's Degree from St. Mary's University. As a CPA he went to work for the accounting firm Thompson Williams Biediger Kastor & Young and later became the managing partner and was instrumental in the transition to ABIP, P.C. His hobbies included playing poker, traveling, and driving his Corvette through the Hill Country. Lee was proud of his daughters and enjoyed playing with his grandson. He was preceded in death by his parents, Mitchel and Lilyan Schwartzman and his brother, Mark.
