



Heriberto Delgado Trevino

September 22, 1945 - July 27, 2022

Heriberto 'Eddie' Treviño, 76, passed away on July 27, 2022, surrounded by his family.

Eddie was known to his friends and family as a wise man. He counseled that worrying was a waste of time because it didn't affect the outcome. When cooking (for which he was known far and wide), he warned not to add too much spice because you can always add, but never take it away. About piñata duty, he solemnly advised to stuff it with plenty of candy (and money) and use lots of rope for good swinging. And always (ALWAYS) get to Reuben's by 5AM during the Christmas season if you want any chance of getting tamales for the holidays.

Most importantly, the wisdom he shared is the belief that everyone deserves respect, patience and acceptance. His generous spirit extended throughout his life. He counseled youth in church, advocated for Postal workers as a Union officer, and always had an ear, a shoulder or a hand to lend to his family.

Eddie was born to José and Anita Treviño on Sept 22, 1945 in San Benito, TX. After graduating from San Benito High School in 1965, Eddie enlisted in the Army and served in Vietnam. He was awarded the Army Commendation Medal (First Oak Leaf Cluster) for Meritorious Service. Assigned to complete his military commitment in San Antonio in 1969, he spent just enough time at Fort Sam Houston to meet Maria Alicia 'Alice' Mendez, the girl of his dreams who worked at the Post library.

He married Alice in 1969, who survives him. Eddie is also survived by his two daughters, Liza (Stephen DePaul) and Anna-Alicia (Nick Tucker), his cat, Palomita, his sister Bertha (Raul) De Los Santos, and Alice's large Mendez family of siblings, cousins and in-laws who Eddie embraced as his own the moment he met Alice.

Eddie was a loving and compassionate husband, father, brother and friend - he will be missed!
