Herminia Guerrero Guerra, lovingly known as “Hermie”, age 84, passed away November 28, 2016 in San Antonio, Texas. She was surrounded by her entire family at the time of her death and went peacefully home to be with the Lord.

She was always passionate about sharing her faith in Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior. She was a great intercessor and prayer warrior for all her friends and family. She will be greatly missed.
