Hettie Leary Cox went to be with the Lord on February 16, 2007. She graduated from Charleston High School in Charleston, South Carolina, attended Hunter College in New York City, joined the US Navy and served for three years during WWII. She lived in Sweetwater, TX for 27 years and moved to Boerne, TX in 1973. Hettie was a pioneer and lifetime member of the Boerne New Comers Club and was a member of Fair Oaks Ranch Country Club, where she loved to play tennis and also a member of St. Helena's Episcopal Church.
