



## Hildon Wright Stroud

February 24, 1919 - October 27, 2006

Hildon Wright Stroud passed away during the early morning hours of Friday, October 27, 2006. Family and friends, who have watched this strong-spirited man suffer from Alzheimer's Disease, mourn his death but rejoice in his life and the hope of eternal life. "Stroud" was the oldest of five boys born to Thomas Hildon and Mary York Stroud on February 24, 1919 in Wheeling, Arkansas. He grew up in Arkansas and Oklahoma, worked in the West Texas Oil Patch and served our country in the United States Army during World War II in Germany. Stroud settled in San Antonio with his wife Martha where he established a successful family business followed by a long term civilian career at Lackland Air Force Base. He is remembered as taking great pride in the fine details of his work as a committed business and service man, as a strong husband, as a faithful father, and as a joyful grandpa. Stroud is preceded in death by his parents and three brothers. Surviving family include his faithful, devoted wife of 51 years, Martha Fay Curren Stroud; daughter, Marcia Stroud Bicknase; son and daughter-in-law, Rodger and Dianne Lewis; grandchildren, Dawn Lewis Gorman with husband, Jay and Amber Bicknase Cerda with husband, Mario; great-grandchildren, Jack Gorman, III and Jenna Grace Gorman; brother, Ogden Stroud with wife, Mary Lou.
