Uribe Sr., born in San Ignacio, Texas on June 29, 1921 was called by Our Lord to be reunited with his loving wife of 53 years, Consuelo Alicia, on May 27, 2007. Homero served in the Navy as a Military Policeman, Fireman First Class and Chief Petty Officer and is a defender and survivor of Pearl Harbor. After an honorable discharge from the Navy, Homero worked for the U.S. Dept. of Agriculture as an inspector in Mexico. After returning to the U.S., Homero worked at Kelly Air Force Base until his retirement. After retirement, he translated legal documents from Spanish to English.
