



## Howard M. Wong

October 10, 1925 - October 25, 2023

Howard Moon Wong passed away peacefully on October 25, 2023. He had recently turned 98. He was preceded in death by his wife of 63 years, Guie Git Wong, and his parents and siblings. He was born in New Castle, California on October 10, 1925. The family moved to San Antonio when he was a teenager. He was a graduate of Fox Tech High School. In 1942, Howard was drafted into the U.S. Navy and was stationed primarily on the USS South Dakota which patrolled the South Pacific. Howard was honorably discharged in 1945 after the end of WWII. After serving in the Navy, he returned to San Antonio where he bought his family's store and took over ownership of Grandview Food Center on N. New Braunfels Ave. He could always be found behind the meat counter, with the Dallas Cowboys or San Antonio Spurs games on the tv in the corner. He finally closed Grandview and retired in 2005 at the age of 79. He is survived by his three daughters, Stephanie Wong, Audrey Gruber and Beverly Ross, son-in-law, Kenneth Ross, grandson, Joseph Gruber, granddaughter, Jenna (Ross) Calderon and husband, Josh Calderon, and great-grandchildren, Quinn, Livi, Rye and Echo.

In honor of Howard's wishes, no funeral or memorial service will be held.
