



## Huey "Pat" Jordan

February 13, 1931 - March 14, 2018

Huey "Pat" Jordan, age 87, passed away peacefully on March 14, 2018 in San Antonio, Texas. He was born February 13, 1931 in Ville Platte, Louisiana to Vollie and Laura Jordan and was the youngest of eight children.
