



Hugh Lambert Gonzalez Sr.

September 14, 1934 - June 22, 2020

Hugh Gonzalez, age 85, died Monday afternoon June 22, 2020 at the Frank M. Tejada veterans' home in Floresville Texas. Hugh was a retired Air Force Reserve MSgt, a beloved teacher for the NEISD for 44 years, and a longtime resident of San Antonio. Hugh and his wife Charlcey enjoyed traveling and doing cruises together seeing as much of the world as they could. Hugh wrote poetry, loved his time with his cat Opie, dog Suzy and all of his family. During his active duty Air Force time he was stationed in Tripoli Libya at Wheelus AFB. He later rejoined the Air Force as a reservist spending another 17 years serving before retiring in 1993 as a MSgt. He was a deacon for many years at Oak Ridge Baptist church and served his church for as long as he could. Hugh was preceded in death by his son Randall Wayne Gonzalez, and brother Ed Gonzalez, and is survived by his wife of 63 years Charlcey Eva Gonzalez, son Hugh Lambert Gonzalez Jr (Rocky), daughter Rhonda Ruth Zalewa and son in-law Paul Zalewa, daughter in-law Gloria Gonzalez. 2 brothers Bob and Randy. 2 sisters Yleene and Delores, 4 grandchildren Rhiannon, Rebecca, Stephanie and Randi. 6 great grandchildren. 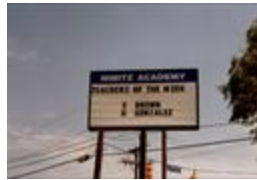
