



## Huland Eugene McAdams

February 29, 1920 - March 23, 2007

Huland Eugene McAdams was welcomed home to Heaven on March 24, 2007 at the age of 87. He was born in Lauderdale County, Alabama on February 29, 1920. He graduated in 1939 from High school in Rogersville, Alabama. He joined the US Army Air Corp in 1942. “Mac” served his country honorably as a flight engineer and a top turret gunner on a B-24. “Mac” flew over 30 combat missions in the central Pacific with the 7th Army Air Force, 30th Bomb Group.

After the war, he attended Dallas Aviation College. While in school in Dallas, Texas, he met the love of his life, Adeline Rust of Wimberley, Texas. They fell in love and were married on November 8, 1947.

“Mac” became an Aircraft Propulsion Equipment Specialist for San Antonio Air Material Management at Kelly AFB. He was also an Aircraft Accident investigator for the USAF and traveled to investigate aircraft accident sites both in the USA and overseas. He retired in 1977.

Mr. McAdams was preceded in death by his parents, Homer E. and Cora Speigel McAdams, three sisters and three brothers.

He is survived by his wife of nearly 60 years, Adeline Rust McAdams, one daughter, Sherry Lynn Keller, son-in-law, Erwin, and grandson, Kyle Ross

Keller and wife Elizabeth, and grand daughter Kristin Jill Keller. He is also survived by one brother, Wendell Delmer McAdams and many nieces and nephews.

“Mac” was a very loving husband, father and grandfather. He was active in his community and especially his church, where he had a special love for evangelism and lay ministry.
