Ida Lillian Sacre embraced eternal peace on Nov. 7, 2009. Born to Albert and Mildred Buppert in Hobson, VA, April 8, 1931, she joined the Army in 1949 and was assigned to Fort Sam Houston, where she met her husband, Emil A. Sacre. She touched hundreds of students' lives during her 35-year teaching career at St. Gregory the Great Catholic School. She was preceded in death by her husband, parents, brother Frank, and grandchild Cassandra Rodriguez.
