Inez Beverly Hinchcliff passed into our heavenly father's arms suddenly Saturday, April 28, 2007, at the age of 65 after a brief illness. She was born May 2, 1941, in San Antonio, TX and attended Hot Wells Elem. and Jr. High Schools and graduated from Brackenridge H.S. in 1958 and also attended San Antonio College one year. Her primary career encompassed varying degrees of senior secretarial positions with the USAF Security Service from 1958 and later was the Support Group Commander's Secretary and AFPC Chief of Civilian Personnel Office at Randolph AFB, the position from which she retired in May of 2002. During her 30-year career, she distinguished herself with numerous senior awards. She was also her family's genealogist and she and Joe spent years researching their respective families' histories. As a teenager and young adult, she was a member of Hot Wells Baptist Church and more recently First Baptist Church of San Antonio, where she volunteered feeding the homeless at Manna. Her favorite recreation was traveling in her motor home. Inez is survived by her husband of 27 years Joseph C. Hinchcliff of San Antonio; one daughter Natalie Kay with her husband Mark Valyan and their three daughters Chelsea, Meghan, and Hannah Inez of Humble TX; two step children: Lark Koontz of Ft. Worth and Mark Hinchcliff of San Antonio, TX and their families. She is also survived by a sister Jan Hagan of Dripping Springs TX; a sister Diane Pruessner and brother-in-law John Pruessner of Fredricksburg TX; one niece Kaye Lynne

Bonner of Cedar Park TX; one nephew Jonathon L.H. Pruessner of Tucson AZ; and one special dog "Roxy". She was preceded in death by her parents L.H. McCarver, Jr. and Gladys Inez McCarver.
