They were married for twenty-four years, until his death on March 6, 1978. She lived in Floresville for twenty five plus years, during this time she was a member of St. Anthony Catholic Church in Elmendorf where she taught First Communion classes for several years and was an active member of the Guadalupe Society. She loved spending time with her grandchildren and great grandchildren. Some of her many hobbies included reading, embroidery and

sewing for her family. She also loved taking care of her plants and her pets. One of her many talents was crocheting, and she crocheted personalized blankets for each of her children and many of her grandchildren.
