January 16, 1927 - June 6, 2013

Irvin R. Beadle age 86 of San Antonio passed away on June 6, 2013. Irvin was born in Berwick, LA. January 16, 1927 to Sydney and Mary Beadle, who preceded him in death. He served in the US Navy during WW II with numerous campaigns and a Presidential Citation.
