December 3, 1919 - July 2, 2006

Isela Correoso Romero. Born in Camaguey, Cuba, December 3, 1919, joined our Lord July 2, 2006 after a short illness. Descendant of one of Cuba's oldest families, her father Dr. Felipe Correoso was an educator, distinguished lawyer and legislator who reformed Cuban education and labor laws and signed the Constitution of 1940. Her mother, Mina was a distinguished academic painter. She married in 1945 Dr. Emilio J. Romero and were divorced in 1961. She earned a PhD in Education from the University of Havana in 1944. Mrs. Romero was an altruist throughout her life. Her devotion to her family was surpassed by none. She lived in Havana, Miami, Madrid and during the last 30 years a resident of San Antonio and Fredericksburg, Texas. She was a devout Catholic and a parishioner of Blessed Sacrament and St. Mary's Fredericksburg. She is survived by her only son, Dr. Emilio F. Romero, her niece Vivian Latour, her nephew Sixto F. Aquino, great nieces Vivian May, Annette Masferrer, Thais de Leon Perez, Yvette Latour, Desiree Cueto and Ma. Belen Aquino and great nephew Felipe Aquino.
