



## Ismael Gabriel Rosas

May 29, 1969 - September 8, 2019

It is with deep sadness that the family of Ismael Gabriel Rosas, loving father, grandfather, and son, announces his sudden passing on Sunday, September 8, 2019, at the early age of 50. Gabriel, dear family member and friend, was born in Lubbock, Texas, on May 29, 1969, to Ismael Rosas and Rita Montelongo Marquez.

Gabriel graduated from San Angelo Central High School in 1988. 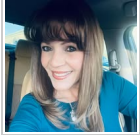
