August 30, 1919 - December 18, 2004

Jack Burton Cunningham left this earth peacefully in his sleep on December 18, 2004 at the age of 85. He was preceded in death by his mother, Mary Anna Nixon Caldwell Cunningham and father, Jordan Lee Cunningham, infant daughter Dorothy May, and twin brothers Ray and Russell Cunningham. He is survived by his wife of 55 years, Akiko O. Cunningham and five daughters, Miki Collins Norman, Susan Doerr John Paul, Cathy Cunningham, Jackie Cortese Ron, Terry Siminski Joseph, 6 grandchildren, 3 great-grandchildren, brother Ret. Lt. Col. Gordon Lee Cunningham, sister-in-law, Helen Martin and several nieces and nephews. Born in south San Antonio on August 30, 1919, he was a lifelong resident of San Antonio, graduating from Harlandale High School in 1936 and serving in the U.S. Army during World War II. While working as a Philco Tech Rep. in Japan, he met Akiko, and returned to his native Texas with his wife and daughter in 1951. Before retiring from Civil Service in 1979, he worked as a supply management representative assigned to the Fifth Army logistics office at Ft. Sam Houston. After retirement, his greatest pleasures were maintaining the lawns of his Aki Park, spoiling his dogs, and fishing the white bass run every spring with his brothers.
