



## Jackson Eng

January 29, 1933 - August 13, 2017

On August 13, Jackson Eng passed away due to complications from a severe case of a rare condition called TENS.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Hong Ping Eng and Lee Yit Ho. He is survived by his wife of almost 60 years, Pearl; his brother, Jim, and his wife, Lan; his sister, Frances; his sister, Jen; his sister, Dori, and her husband, Don; his daughter, Peggy, and her husband, Steve; his son, Darryl, and his wife, Mary; his grandchildren, Aliana, Jackson, and Noah; dozens of cousins, nieces, and nephews.

Born in San Antonio in 1933, Jackson was a proud graduate of Brackenridge High School. Later, he earned his undergraduate degree from The University of Texas at Austin, and his MSW from Our Lady of the Lake University in San Antonio.

Following a brief stint in the Army during the Korean War, Jackson returned to the States to finish his studies at UT. After working for the Jewish Community Center, he was encouraged to pursue his Master's Degree. Education completed, he and Pearl spent 40 years in the D/FW Metroplex. The majority of that time he was a teacher and counselor at Tarrant County College. Upon retiring in 1994, he began work in earnest on his dream home. With construction completed by 2005, Jackson and Pearl returned to the San

Antonio area where they had both grown up.

Jackson was a beloved husband, father, brother, uncle, and friend to hundreds of people whose lives he touched over the years. After he is laid to rest at Mission Park South, a private memorial service will honor his life and accomplishments. The memorial service will start at 2:30 p.m. on Saturday, August 26, at Mission Park Funeral Chapels Stone Oak.
