James Warren Green, of Floresville, passed away peacefully at home on November 17, 2010 at the age of 89. He is preceded in death by his father and mother, Hubert W. Green, Sr. and Lois Coleman Hockaday, and son-in-law Larry Buck. He is survived by his loving wife, Annie L. Green of Floresville and brother, Hubert W. Green and wife Leah Green of San Antonio; children: Andrea Buck of Houston, Bill Green of Smithville and Robbi Shipley and husband Jim of San Antonio; seven grandchildren: Lance Buck, Jamie Buck, Kristy and Michael Hayes, Kelly Shipley, Ryan Shipley, and Morgan Sigler; and three great-grandchildren: Lauren Hayes, Tyler Hayes and Tripp Shipley and numerous nephews and nieces. Warren, or “Jimmy” as he was known to his wife, friends and co-workers, was reared in San Antonio. He attended Alamo Heights and Brackenridge High School, graduating in 1938. He then entered Texas A & M University to study aeronautical engineering, and later joined the Army during WWII. He also attended schools in California pursuing his aeronautical interests, and worked at aircraft companies such as North American Aviation, Northrop Aircraft, and Hughes Aircraft Co., using his artistic talents to help design and build many of the aircraft used in WWII. While in California he pursued his love of music, and played drums in several nationally known dance bands of that era. Later he moved back to San Antonio to work at Air Force installations such as Kelly Field, Randolph Field

and Brooks Air Force Base School of Medicine, where he retired as a medical illustrator. There, he received government awards for his exceptional illustrations. At Brooks, he met his beloved wife of 47 years, Annie. They have spent the intervening years on their farm near Floresville where Jimmy has enjoyed hobbies such as art collection, cabinetry, painting, and antique clock repairing. He loved to play his drums, jazz being his favorite music. Jimmy was a talented and exceptional artist, not only in his own efforts, but in recognizing the unique good in any work of art. Loved by his family and friends, he will be dearly missed.
