



James Talmage Pearce

August 27, 1928 - September 11, 2017

James T. Pearce, (Jim), 89 passed away on September 11, 2017 in San Antonio, Texas surrounded by his loving family. Jim was born in Albertville, Alabama to Albert Leamon and Alpha Lilla (Daniel) Pearce on August 27, 1928. He was a 1947 graduate of Trinity High School in Trinity, Alabama. Right after graduating, he joined the US Air Force where he served 6 years active duty during the Korean War. He returned to San Antonio, where he continued to serve in the Air Force Reserves, and retired in 1988 as a Colonel in the Medical Service Corps.

After Jim's return from Korea to San Antonio, he attended Trinity University earning a B.S. degree in Finance and Economics in 1956. For several years he worked for Mutual of New York before joining the Tower Life Ins. Co. At the time of his retirement, he was Vice President and Director of Marketing. Jim was also active in several civic and social organizations including the San Antonio Junior Chamber of Commerce, the Greater San Antonio Chamber of Commerce, Military Affairs Council, San Antonio Downtown Rotary Club, and the USAF Medical Service Corps Association.

Jim was preceded in death by his dear brothers, Dale Pearce and A.L. Pearce; and his cherished sisters, Linda Loyce Pearce and Brenda McDaniel. He is survived by his dearest wife of 62 years, Toni (Blowers) Pearce; his much loved daughters, Sandi Trimble (Tom), Cindy Haven (Jerry), Liz Campbell (Pete), and Nancy Marek (Frank). Also surviving him are his pride and joy, his grandchildren, Alex Trimble, Will Trimble, Rachel Campbell, Kelly

Campbell, Madison Marek, Brianna Marek, and Zachary Marek. He is also survived by his sister Barbara Surgi, and his brother B.C. Pearce (Lynda Faye) along with numerous nieces and nephews of who he was especially proud. And numerous cousins.
